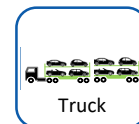
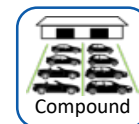
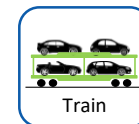
Digitalisation WG (DWG) structure



New structure



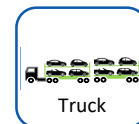
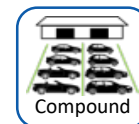
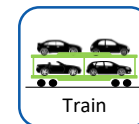
- The DWG had initially three sub-groups (Telematics, e-Gate, e-documents), of which the only active group was Telematics

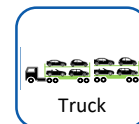
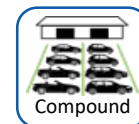
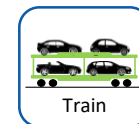
- Co-operation with the VDA WG Connected Vehicle re. the communication within the supply chain
- 4 use-case groups established till the end of the year
 - VDA and non-VDA OEMs, as well as LSPs collaborate
 - Field tests also included
 - Results to be presented at the ECG Conference (October 2018) and the Odette Conference (November 2018)
 - Recommendations to be drafted early 2019



Close range vehicle identification



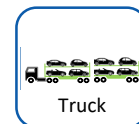
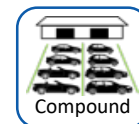
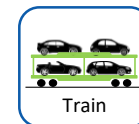
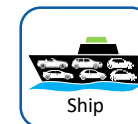
- Proposal for a new sub-group on close range vehicle ID

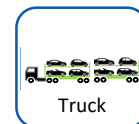
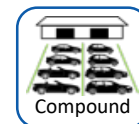
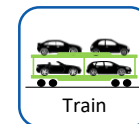
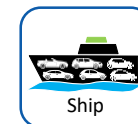
- ECG decided to approach ERTICO (European Intelligent Transport organisation) which has a relevant project

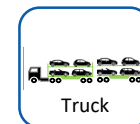
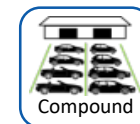
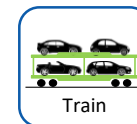
- ECG published a joint statement with IRU on e-CMR in January 2017
- Since then other organisations, bigger than ECG have taken the lead on the issue so this sub-group is on hold
- ECG is just monitoring the developments now as the European Commission has included this in the Mobility Package
- Michael Bünning will still raise this issue in Berlin as Germany is our top priority
