2016 Results



Profit of +€77,030 vs budget of +€8,577

Key points

- Revenues exceeded budget at +€86k
 - Exceptional Conference revenues +€60k
 - Academy income +€15k
 - ECG Survey +€5k
- Costs broadly in line with budget though General Assembly, ECG Conference and ECG Academy all over budget due to higher numbers than those foreseen





2016 Summary



- Overall a good financial result which will allow ECG to invest in new projects in 2017
- Exceptional growth in ECG Conference with 273 delegates registered
- As usual we received a clear report from our auditors
- Our association is on a sound and stable financial footing with growing membership and also support from our partners











2017 Budget



Proposed budget is for a loss of €39,739

2017 Budget



Specifics

- ECG Conference expected to continue at higher level than in previous years
- 20th Anniversary event held in March in lieu of the normal dinner debate in the European Parliament and this cost more than €40k
- New project work foreseen in conjunction with the OEMs and the joint working groups with €70k allowed – you will hear more about this later
