New car transporters are struggling to survive due to a lack of chips

New car transporters fear for their livelihood in the face of difficulties in the auto industry. According to the Association of European Vehicle Logistics (ECG), the background is the lack of microchips, which has been a problem for vehicle manufacturers for a long time. "The branch is struggling for the foreseeable third bad year in a row for the survival and needs the support of the automobile industry", said association president Wolfgang Göbel before the beginning of the ECG annual conference on Thursday in Brussels. According to its own statements, the association represents almost 140 companies, including DB Cargo, the rail freight subsidiary.
